2. Presentation

South Western Integrated Fibre Technology (SWIFT) Update

Geoff Hogan, SWIFT Network Lead provided an update on the SWIFT Initiative.

3. Action Items

A. Bail Hearings – Walkerton Court

On January 5th Regional Senior Justice of the Peace Forester, announced that commencing January 19, 2015 and until further notice, all Judicial Interim Release (Bail) matters for Walkerton would be heard by the Justice of the Peace at the Owen Sound Courthouse, a subsequent notice was issued on January 19th, 2015 as follows: *"Further to the notice of January 5, 2015, please be advised that all bail proceedings will return to Walkerton February 9, 2015."* The Clerk-Treasurer explained that following the initial announcement we learned that the reason for the temporary relocation of certain bail matters, but not all bail matters, was a result of a Court room space shortage due to the Superior Court Trials that were being held in Walkerton. It was intended as an interim measure only. Unfortunately the communication issued lacked details that had they been provided could have avoided the public outcry.

That a letter be sent under the Warden's signature to Bridget Forester, Regional Senior Justice of the Peace, West Region thanking her for the reinstatement of the bail hearings in Walkerton and requesting improved communication in order to ensure the stability of the court system in Walkerton (Bruce County) in the future.
