1. Pecuniary Interest

There were no declarations of pecuniary interest.

2. Action Items

A. West Road

The Engineer reported that no road improvements would be undertaken on the West Road until the Department undertook a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment pursuant to Part 11.1 of the Environmental Assessment Act.

Moved by Councillor Mike Smith Seconded by Councillor Anne Eadie

That the Warden arrange a meeting with local First Nations to discuss the West Road; and,

That the Warden arrange a meeting with local Metis Groups to discuss the West Road; and,

That the Warden be accompanied by the Highways Chair, CAO, Highways Engineer and other staff as required.

Councillor Jackson questioned the possibility of undertaking a new County Road Rationalization Study. The CAO responded indicating that because the 2015 budget has been passed and a new County Road Rationalization Study is not included in the budget, that it could be considered as part of the 2016 budget process.

B. 2015 Capital Road Work, Construction in Glammis Urban

Moved by Councillor Milt McIver Seconded by Councillor Mike Smith

That the Engineer approach the Municipalities of Kincardine and Brockton to inquire if they are prepared to enter an agreement to facilitate the reconstruction of Glammis in 2015 with their contribution to the project in 2016, and if agreeable;

That \$350,000 be reallocated from the 2015 West Road capital project to the 2015 Bruce Road 15G capital project.

C. MTO Intersection Improvement at Highway 21 and the Grey Bruce Line, Alvanley

That the Engineer organize a meeting with Grey County staff to identify options to provide the MTO financial Incentive /assistance to move ahead with the intersection improvement at Highway 21 and the Grey Bruce Line; and,

That a joint delegation request be made with Grey County to meet with the Minister of Transportation at the 2015 OGRA Conference.

D. Quixote One Wind Energy Corporation (Q1WEC) Road Use Agreement

That a bylaw be introduced authorizing the Warden and Clerk to sign a Road Use Agreement between Quixote One Wind Energy Corporation (Q1WEC) and Bruce County.
