2. Public Meeting

A. Bruce County Official Plan Amendment BCOPA #200-15.49

The Chair opened the Public Meeting and indicated that a presentation would be made by the Staff Planner. Following the presentation members of the public will be given an opportunity to speak to the matter. There were no members of the public present to speak to the application.

Moved by Councillor Anne Eadie Seconded by Councillor Robert Buckle

That Bruce County Official Plan Amendment Number 200-15.49 be approved as follows:

5.5.13.62 Notwithstanding the policies of Section 6.5.3.3 (Consents-Agricultural Areas) of this plan, the lands described as Site Specific Policy Area 5.5.13.62 on Schedule "A" Land Use Plan (South Section), (Lots 1-2, Concession 7, geographic Township of Arran, Municipality of Arran-Elderslie) may be divided into more than two parts, but shall not be severed into more than two farm lots and two non-farm lots. All other policies of Section 6.5.3 (Land Division Policies) apply.

B. Bruce County Official Plan Amendment BCOPA #201-16.26

The Chair opened the Public Meeting and indicated that a presentation would be made by the Staff Planner. Following the presentation members of the public will be given an opportunity to speak to the matter.

Mollie Kuchma, Planner presented Bruce County Official Plan Amendment BCOPA #201-16.26. Ms. Kuchma indicated to the Committee that since the time of writing the report, modifications were made to the draft by-law. A copy of the by-law with the recommended changes was presented at the public meeting. Mr. Ron Davidson spoke in support of the application. There were no other members of the public present to speak to the application.

Moved by Councillor Milt McIver Seconded by Warden Mitch Twolan

That Bruce County Official Plan Amendment Number 201-16.26 be approved as follows:

"Schedule "A" Land Use (South Section – Lakeshore)" of the County of Bruce Official Plan is hereby amended as shown on Schedule "A";

Re-designating lands from "Rural Area" to "Rural Recreational Area Special"; and further adding the following to subsection 5.3.11 Exceptions – Rural Recreation Area;

Notwithstanding the policies of 5.3 (Rural Recreational Area) of this Plan, the lands described as Site Specific Policy Area 5.3.11.2 on Schedule "A" Land Use Plan (Part Lots 51-55, Lake Range, geographic Township of Bruce, Municipality of Kincardine) may be used in accordance with the following policy:

Site disturbance shall be limited to a maximum of 0.4 hectares of land per lot, all of which shall occur within the "Rural Recreational Are Special" portion of the lot. More detailed development restrictions as required to carry out the recommendations of the Environmental Impact Study (prepared by AWS dated February 2015) shall be contained in the implementing Zoning By-law Amendment. The exact boundary of the development envelopes shall be provided in the implementing Zoning By-law Amendment.

All other policies of Section 5.3 (Rural Recreational Area) apply.

Re-designating lands from "Rural Area" to "Rural Area Special"; and further, adding the following to subsection 5.6.9 Exceptions – Rural Area:

Notwithstanding the policies of 6.5 (Rural Area) and 6.5.3.4 (Consents – Rural Areas) of this Plan, the lands described as Site Specific Policy Area 5.6.9.22 on Schedule "A" Land Use Plan (Part Lots 51-55, Lake Range, geographic Township of Bruce, Municipality of Kincardine) may be severed to a maximum size of 46.6 hectares and may be subdivided into 3 (three) Non-Farm Residential lots including the retained lot.

A lot shall not be severed until the appropriate zoning has been placed on those lands by way of a Zoning By-law Amendment. The Zoning By-law Amendment shall implement the recommendations of the Environmental Impact Study (prepared by AWS dated February 2015) and, where required, the recommendations of an engineering report pertaining to Floodplan Analysis subject to the satisfaction of the Municipality, County and Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority.

Site disturbance shall be limited to a maximum of 0.4 hectares of land per lot, all of which shall occur within the "Rural Area Special" portion of the lot. More detailed development restrictions as required to carry out the recommendations of the Environmental Impact Study (prepared by AWS dated February 2015) shall be contained in the implementing Zoning By-law Amendment. The exact boundary of the development envelopes shall be provided in the implementing Zoning By-law Amendment.

All other policies of Section 6.5.3 (Land Division Policies) and 5.6 (Rural Area) apply.

Re-designating lands from "Rural Area" and "Hazard Land Area" to "Hazard Land Area Special"; and further, adding the following to subsection 5.8.8 Exceptions – Hazard Land Area:

Notwithstanding the policies of 5.8 (Hazard Land Area) of this Plan, the lands described as Site Specific Policy Area 5.8.8.3 on Schedule "A" Land Use Plan (Part Lots 51-55, Lake Range, geographic Township of Bruce, Municipality of Kincardine) may be used in accordance with the following policy:

No development or site alteration shall be permitted except for the removal of dying or dead trees in the interest of human and property safety. This notwithstanding, site alteration may be permitted in the "Hazard Land Area Special" designation only for the purposes of constructing a driveway as required to obtain vehicular access from the municipal road to "Rural Area Special" designated are of a lot. Such site alteration shall not exceed four metres in width and the area of such site alteration shall be clearly defined in the implementing Zoning By-law.
