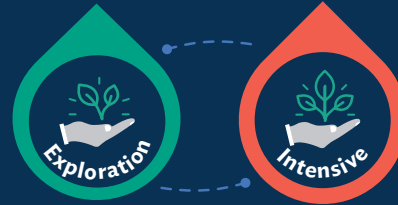
## PARENTS AND CAREGIVERS
