Income Verification

- Recent Notice of Assessment (NOA) from CRA account pages 1 and 2 must be submitted
- Canada Child Benefit (CCB) notice from CRA account pages 1 and 2 must be submitted

The following if applicable

- OSAP information (Ontario Student Assistance Program)
- Confirmation of school enrolment
- Ontario Works/ Ontario Disability confirmation
- Current paystubs
- Letter of employment if paystub is not available
- If Self-employed, self-employment package completed

Verification of Identification

- Social Insurance Number

Referral

- If you are applying based on a referral, we require **2 letters of support** from a current service provider or medical professional.

Custody

- Parents who are separated/single are required to sign a "Declaration of Separation" form
- Custody agreement if available
- Child Care Benefit notice (CCB)

Eligible Hours of Care

- Work/school timetable that lists days and hours required to be in school or at work

Your application for Child Care Subsidy cannot be processed or completed unless all required information is received.
