Eligibility Requirements

- At least one member of the household must be 16 years of age or older.
- All members of the household are a Canadian Citizen, Landed Immigrant (permanent residents) or has Refugee Claimant Status and has no deportation order under the Immigration Act.
- At least one member of the household can live independently.
- No member of the household owes money to any community housing provider In Ontario.
- Total household assets are below \$75,000.
- No member of the household is in receipt of a portable housing benefit.
- Household Income does not exceed the allowable limits, as per the Housing Income Limits (HILs) listed below (line 23600 of your Notice of Assessment):

Completing the Application

An application is considered complete when it has all the following:

If you have children listed on the application and have joint custody or

Notice of Assessment (Income Tax) from Canada Revenue Agency for all
household members 16 years or older who are not full-time students - if this does not reflect current income, then most recent pay stubs or proof of current
income.
If you owe rent arrears to another Community Housing provider and have a
payment plan, please provide a copy of the agreement, as your application can
be pending until the arrears are paid in full.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I know that my application was received?

You will receive a letter or email confirming your application was received. If your application is incomplete, you will be contacted asking for additional documentation. If the additional documentation is not received within 30 days, the application will not be processed.

2. Does Bruce County Housing offer emergency housing?

Bruce County Housing does not offer emergency housing. If you are homeless and living in in Bruce County, contact the YMCA - OSGB by calling 519-371-9222 or 211 afterhours.

3. Can I choose where I want to live?

Yes. All applicants can choose one or more locations on the application. Your name will be added to waitlist for each location where you are eligible.

4. How long is the waitlist?

The length of time varies depending on the chosen locations and the size of unit. In some instances, it can take longer due to a limited number of vacancies. In most cases it is approximately 3-5 years.

5. Do I have to update my application?

Yes, once a year you will be formally asked to update your application. However, any time you change your contact information, such as your address, phone number or email, it must be updated within 30 days of the change to ensure your application remains active on the waitlist.

6. Can I make changes to my application?

7. Can I make changes to my application online?

Yes. Updates can be made online by visiting www.socialhousingapplication.com. If you have a current application, contact a Program Assistant to receive your registration/applicant code.

8. What if I refuse a unit offered to me?

When your name gets to the top of the waitlist you will be contacted with an offer of housing. If you refuse the offer of housing your application will be cancelled.

9. How does Bruce County contact me when my name comes to the top of the list?

Bruce County Housing Staff will contact you by using the information provided on your application. If we are unable to contact you within 48 hours, an offer will be made to the next person on the list and your application will be cancelled.

10. Am I eligible if I own my own home?

If you own a residential property that can be used all year, you are required to sell the property within 180 days after moving into a rent-geared-to-income unit.

11. How much rent will I pay?

Rent geared to income is based on 30% of your adjusted family net income according to your Canada Revenue Notice of Assessment, or if you are receiving assistance from Ontario Works or Ontario Disability Support Program, it is based on a rent scale. Therefore, applicants are required to have their tax assessments up to date.



- 4. The County of Bruce can share the information on this form and any attachments to the government of Canada, a department, ministry, or agency of it, without further notice to me if the information is necessary of administering or enforcing the *Income Tax Act (Canada)* or the *Immigration Act*.
- 5. The County of Bruce can share the information on this form and any attachment to any government or body with whom the County of Bruce has made an agreement under the *Housing Services Act*, 2011, without further notice to me, for the purpose of conducting research relating to a social benefit program or social housing or rentgeared-to-income assistance program.
- 6. The County of Bruce can disclose and collect personal information about me from the following parties: person to contact in my absence; relevant agencies; credit bureaus and or other businesses, rent supplement landlords and individuals that provide credit or rental information to determine my eligibility.
- 7. Any information on this form and any attachment given by the County of Bruce or private landlords to body listed above is confidential and will only be given in accordance with the *Housing Services Act*, 2011 and associated regulations.

I/we the undersigned understand and declare that:

- 1. All information given in this application is correct and complete, including supporting documents. If something on this application is incorrect or not true, the County of Bruce or the housing providers applied to, may request additional information, may cancel the application or both. Applicants may be prohibited from re-applying for assistance for a minimum period of two years under the *Housing Services Act*, 2011.
- 2. All information given to the County of Bruce will belong to them and they will give the information to the housing providers chosen.

- 3. Only the people listed on this application form may live with me/us in subsidized housing.
- 4. The County of Bruce will use the information given to see if I/we qualify for the housing I/we have applied for, to see if I/we continue to qualify for rent-geared-to-income assistance and to see how much assistance I/we are eligible for.
- 5. I/we are in Canada legally.
- 6. This application will be removed, or my date of application may change if I/we refuse an offer of accommodation.
- 7. Before an offer of housing, I/we understand that I/we must pay back or make arrangements that are satisfactory to the County of Bruce, to pay any arrears I/we owe with respect to any subsidized housing project.
- 8. Effective March 1, 2021, it is mandatory for all tenants to purchase their own tenant insurance coverage to insure against loss or damage of property or the cost of any claims against the tenant for damages to the tenant's unit or injury to other people.
