Dear Sir/Madam,

The County of Bruce (County) has retained the services of Triton Engineering Services Limited (Triton) to commence with a Schedule 'A+' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA). Initiated in 2021, works were planned in two (2) phases to address alternative options for the vertical realignment and rehabilitation of Bruce Road 6 East A (BR6EA).

The Study will evaluate the roadway vertical alignment and will recommend a preferred plan to address the traffic needs within the project area. Improvements to BR6EA are required to address safety concerns associated with the vertical curves and to rehabilitate the existing pavement structure.

Phase 1 of construction was carried out in 2023/2024 extending from Mildmay to Deemerton (George Street to east of Sideroad 20 N) including reconstruction of Sideroad 20.

Phase 2 of the reconstruction of BR6EA is planned to be carried out in 2027 under the direction of Triton Engineering and will extend from east of Sideroad 20 to Grey Road 10. Investigative works and detailed design will be carried out during 2026, with an opportunity for public consultation/input.

A **Survey/Investigation** is also being scheduled for this Spring/Summer 2026. On behalf of the County, Triton Engineering will be proceeding with preliminary engineering work for the future construction of BR6EA. As part of this work, staff from Triton Engineering will be undertaking a topographic survey of the roadway including front yards and buildings which will provide information to facilitate the engineering design. The survey crew will comprise of two persons and appropriate survey equipment.

The purpose of this letter is to reintroduce the project and invite initial comments and feedback for consideration and influence in the decision-making process. Consultation with affected residents, area property owners or interested stakeholders is a key element in the

planning process. **There will be an opportunity at any time during the EA process for interested parties to provide comments. Early identification of individual and group concerns greatly aids in addressing these concerns.** Persons will be advised of future communication opportunities by newspaper public notices. Notices on the County website and through direct mail outs via Canada Post or email distribution.

The attached Notice of Commencement will also be advertised on the County's website <https://www.brucecounty.on.ca/bruce-road-6-east>, which also provides more details of the project.

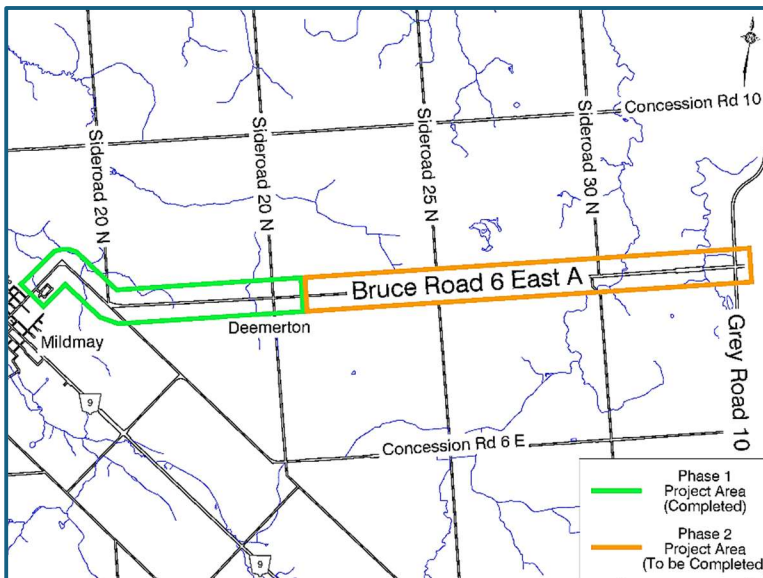
Introduction

The County of Bruce (County) has retained Triton Engineering Services Limited (Triton) to undertake an Environmental Assessment (EA) Study and Detailed Design for **Phase 2** of the reconstruction of Bruce Road 6 East A (BR6EA).

Phase 1 of the Reconstruction of BR6EA was carried out in 2023/2024 extending from Mildmay to Deemerton (George Street to east of Sideroad 20) including reconstruction of Sideroad 20.

Phase 2 of the reconstruction of BR6EA is planned to be carried out in 2027 and will extend from east of Sideroad 20 to Grey Road 10. Investigative works and detailed design will be carried out by Triton Engineering during 2026, with an opportunity for public consultation/input.

The Study will evaluate the roadway vertical alignment and will recommend a preferred plan to address the traffic needs within the project area. Improvements to BR6EA are required to address safety concerns associated with the vertical curves and to rehabilitate the existing pavement structure.



Study Process:

This project study has been planned, implemented and being completed as a Schedule 'A+' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Municipal Engineers Association, March 2023) to identify, evaluate and make recommendations to determine the design and staging to address the rehabilitation of Bruce County Road 6 East A (BR6EA). Notice and consultation with affected residents and area property owners is a key element in this planning process.
