BRUCE ROAD 25

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - ROAD CLOSURE

As outlined in the feature map, the County of Bruce and the Town of Saugeen Shores are completing reconstruction work on Bruce Road 25, at the south end of Port Elgin.

Reconstruction of the water and sewer are nearing completion. Construction to Bruce Road 25 will begin in September and is planned for completion by November 2020.

Recent safety concerns have resulted in changes to the construction methods that will be employed at the site. It is now necessary to close Bruce Road 25 from Bruce Road 33 going easterly for approximately 350 meters. **This section will remain closed to through traffic from Monday August 24th, 2020 until November 2020.**

Emergency services will be required to use the posted detour to access properties west of 77 Bruce Road 25, (Lakerange Service Centre) and Gobles Grove.

The County of Bruce and the Town of Saugeen Shores apologizes for any inconvenience this road work may cause.
