The proposed changes affect all of Section 6, Implementation, and all of Section 7, Interpretation, of the Plan. Further amendments are proposed to selected portions of Section 4, General Policies, related to policies for Servicing and the Niagara Escarpment Plan. Overall, the amendment will make the plan more concise, and easy to use, while making the policies of the plan more effective.
